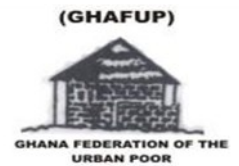


NEGBA (KOOSEKOOSE)

Settlement Profile



OVERVIEW

Negba is located in the Klowe Koo Naa electoral area of Nungua. There are over 800 structures in the settlement, of which 100% of these are made from concrete. The Nungua Traditional Council is the legal custodian of the land.

The settlement is under no imminent threat of eviction.

Community Development Priorities

Education and Health Care

Seven schools and 5 nursery centers exist with Negba. However, there is only one clinic which is privately owned and a CHIP compound.

Economic Activities

Artisanship and petty trading are the major sources of employment available to the economically active. It is believed there are 30% percent of formal workers and 70% informal workers in the community. The monthly income of settlement members ranges between GHC 300.00 and GHC 700 for those employed in the formal sector and between GHC120.00 and GHC200.00 for those in the informal sector.

Governance

The settlement operates on a two-tier local government system, that is, the elected assembly member and unit committee. In addition, there is sub traditional council that advice the settlement on development issues. There are no NGOs operating in the community but there are CBOs such as: Vatican Fun Club, Tropical Fun Club and Women of Gold.
